- 2. Head to the exhibitor areas between presentations.** Connect with academic areas, Student Financial Aid, club sports and more until noon. Tip: The exhibitor areas are in the Bowen-Thompson Student Union Ballroom and upstairs in Room 308.
- 3. Preview Day activities are hosted in buildings all over campus.** Start your day in the Bowen-Thompson Student Union for check-in and to check out the exhibitor areas. Then make your way around campus for presentations and tours. If you need help, refer to the map on pages 22-23.
- 4. Stop by the Preview Day information tables to connect with experts.** We can help you select the best activities for the day, provide directions, answer questions and more. We'll be available in the Bowen-Thompson Student Union Ballroom from 8:30 a.m. to noon. After noon, you can find assistance until 2 p.m. outside Falcon Outfitters on the first floor of the Bowen-Thompson Student Union. 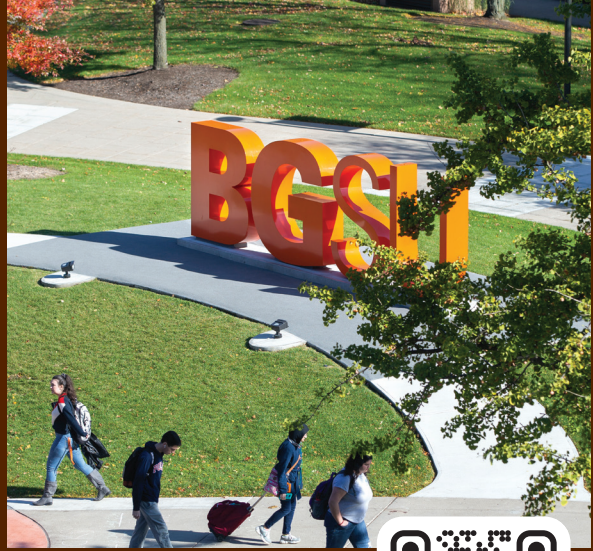
